Dear Resident,

This letter is to inform you that the City of Cleveland, Division of Water Pollution Control will undertake a project to provide an added level of protection against flooding on East 97 Street in the City of Cleveland. The **East 97 Street Sewer Project** is scheduled to commence the week of February 5, 2024. This project consists of excavating to replace approximately 1,700 feet of main sewer on East 97 Street between Quebec Avenue and Cedar Avenue.

The City of Cleveland has contracted with Fabrizi Trucking and Paving, Inc. to perform this work.

The City of Cleveland will work with the contractor and you to insure minimum inconvenience during the construction period. The contractor will install barricades within the limits of the construction area. The sewer excavation will take approximately 3 months to complete. The pavement will be restored in the trench area and the street will be resurfaced within the limits of work. We ask for your cooperation in observing all traffic regulations and following detour signs.
